SYMPTOMATIC

If you are experiencing any of the following...

- Fever (100.4 F or higher)
- Chills
- Muscle pain
- Sore throat
- Loss of sense of smell or taste
- Runny nose and congestion
- Gastrointestinal symptoms of diarrhea, vomiting or nausea
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Headache
- Fatigue

- Stay home for 10 days since symptoms started, fever free for 24 hours, and symptom have improved
 - Remote learning

- Stay home until feeling better, fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication, and any medical orders have been completed

- Stay home for 10 days since symptoms started, fever free for 24 hours, and symptom have improved
- Remote learning

- Quarantine for 14 days or 10 days from symptom onset, whichever is longer

- YELLOW**
- RED** Mandatory quarantine for 10 days.
COVID antigen test recommended the day exposure is known
To shorten quarantine to 7 days (returning day 8) a negative COVID test must be done on day 6 or 7 after exposure

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ASYMPTOMATIC

...but exposed to COVID *positive* or *probable* case for 15 minutes or more within 6ft

VACCINATED

- 1 Monitor for symptoms of COVID for 14 days
- 2 Attend School
- 3

GREEN

- Mask Recommended until receiving negative test on day 3-5
- COVID antigen testing is available on day exposure is known and 3-5 days after exposure

YELLOW

- Attend School
- Mask Recommended
- COVID antigen testing is encouraged on day exposure is known and 3-5 day following exposure until receiving a negative test

ORANGE

- To stay in school, COVID antigen testing on day exposure is known and 3-5 day following an exposure is **MANDATORY**
- Wearing a mask is recommended until resolving a negative test on day 3-5

RED

- To stay in school, COVID antigen testing on day exposure is known and 3-5 day following an exposure is **MANDATORY**
- Wearing a mask is required

If the student tests positive at any time, the student must stay home and isolate for 10 days from date of positive test

NON-VACCINATED

- Mandatory COVID antigen testing on day exposure is known
