To stay in school, COVID antigen testing on day exposure is known and 3-5 day following an exposure is MANDATORY Wearing a mask is recommended until resolving a negative test on day 3-5

To stay in school, COVID antigen testing on day exposure is known and 3-5 day following an exposure is MANDATORY

Wearing a mask is required

If the student tests positive at any time, the student must stay home and isolate for 10 days from date of positive test

Mandatory quarantine for 10 days. COVID antigen test recommended the day exposure is known To shorten quarantine to 7 days (returning day 8) a negative COVID test must be done on day 6 or 7 after exposure

If the student tests positive at any time, the student must stay home and isolate for 10 days from date of positive test
