# Pewaukee High School Class of 2019 Produces Strong ACT Results

ACT composite score of 24.0 one of the highest in school history

**Pewaukee, WI** - Mike Cady, Pewaukee School District Superintendent, released the following statement after the statewide release of ACT results for the Class of 2019 on Wednesday, October 16th.

The Pewaukee School District is pleased to report strong results for the graduating class of 2019 on the ACT. The average composite score of 24.0 is well above the state average score in Wisconsin of 20.3 and the national average of 20.8 (2018). These results are tied with those from the class of 2016 as the highest for the district since 100% of students were required to take the test and represents a 1.2 point improvement over the past two years.

“We are happy to see strong ACT scores for our recent graduates as one indicator showing our students are being well prepared for post-secondary opportunities. Most importantly this provides recognition of the hard work of our students and staff” said Mike Cady, Pewaukee School District Superintendent. “This is one data point of many that we monitor in our ongoing work to prepare our graduates for the future.”
