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Pewaukee School District Assessment Results Continue to Exceed Statewide Averages

Pewaukee, WI - Pewaukee School District exceeds averages in statewide assessments and testing across all four schools.

Pewaukee High School's class of 2020 American College Testing (ACT) performance was a composite of 23.0. This year's score is well above the state average of 19.7. Overall, students improved moderately in reading and declined slightly in Math and English. Pewaukee High School ranked 14th for the highest score in the state amongst 457, non-charter high schools.

Grades 9 and 10 participated in the ACT Aspire with the 9th grade performance increasing in all subject areas. Greatest improvements include English from a 77.2% to 82.9% proficiency and Reading from a 57.2% to 60.6% proficiency. The 10th grade performance mirrored the overall state shifts in results; however, all subjects remained well above the state average by 10-20 percentage points.

Grades 3 through 8 participated in the state Forward exam in Math and English Language Arts. Additionally, grades 4, 8, and 10 participate in science and social studies testing. Overall, Pewaukee School District students performed well above state averages with Horizon Elementary and Asa Clark Middle School scores in the top 20% of scores statewide.
