Pewaukee School District State Report Card Significantly Exceeds Expectations

Pewaukee, WI - Pewaukee School District received a rating of Significantly Exceeds Expectations on the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction Report Cards released November 14, 2023. Pewaukee High School and Horizon Elementary School also received a Significantly Exceeds Expectations rating and Asa Clark Middle School received an Exceeds Expectations rating.

Pewaukee High School's class of 2024 American College Testing (ACT) performance was a composite of 22.7. This year's score is well above the state average of 19.3. Grades 3 through 8 participated in the state Forward exam in Math and English Language Arts. Additionally, grades 4, 8, and 10 participate in science and social studies testing. Grades 9 and 10 participated in the PreACT. Overall, Pewaukee School District students performed well above state averages on all assessments and continues to be amongst the top performing school districts in the state.
