Pewaukee, WI - The Pewaukee School District received a rating of *Significantly Exceeds Expectations* on the State Report Card released by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) on November 15th, reflecting results from the 2021-22 School Year. This five star rating is the highest possible on the state report card. Schools and districts across the state receive scores in the areas of Student Achievement, Growth, Closing Gaps, and On-Track and Postsecondary Readiness which combine to make up the rating. Pewaukee High School as well as Horizon Elementary also achieved a rating of *Significantly Exceeds Expectations* with increased percentages of students proficient or advanced in both English and Math. Pewaukee Lake Elementary does not receive a typical state report card as they do not have a grade level that participates in state testing. Of the two categories presented for a non-state testing school, “Not Making Satisfactory Progress” or “Satisfactory Progress,” Pewaukee Lake Elementary received the latter.
