## How to set up a wireless connection away from school:

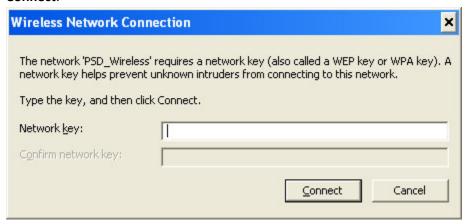
- 1. Log in using the **Workstation only** option on the Novell- login screen. You should make sure the box is checked next to Workstation only prior to entering in your user name and password. Otherwise, the computer will be searching for the Pewaukee network and the login will fail.
- 2. In the bottom right hand corner of the system tray, you will see a wireless connection icon. Right-click on this and select **View Available Wireless Connections**.



3. You should see your wireless network listed. If not click **Refresh network list** (on the top left of the box).



- 4. Click and select your wireless network from the list.
- 5. Click the **Connect** button on the bottom of the window.
- 6. Your network should require a secure key for connection and security. **Enter the network security key** and click **Connect**.



- 7. With the correct key, you should have access. Click **Connect**. Your laptop should now be connected to your home network.
- 8. This process should only need to be completed the first time you take your laptop home or if the security key should change on your home wireless network. The Pewaukee IT Department cannot assist in identifying or determining security keys of individual home networks, nor can we provide trouble-shooting for individual Internet Service Providers.
