COVID-19 Update

May 10, 2021

Weekly Update Data: This information is provided in an effort to be transparent with the level of COVID-19 virus activity within the school district. Please note that information relative to any individual's health is very sensitive and private so we are taking steps to secure the anonymity of individuals. Student numbers will be published at a school level and the district as a whole. In any school in which the number is <5 we will post an * to avoid the likelihood of exposing the identity of an individual. We will provide a summary number for the district as a whole. For staff, because they are fewer in number, we will only post that information for the district as a whole.

Phase Status: *Current level = Phase 3; *Grades 4K -12 (Full attendance Mon - Friday)*

Great news - we have our **lowest number of infections and quarantined students since the start of the school year!** To maintain our success and ensure a strong finish to the school year it remains important for students with viral symptoms to stay at home (from school AND athletic practices - school or youth programs). In accordance with ongoing guidance from Public Health Officials we urge parents to have your child(ren) tested if they are symptomatic or have been exposed to someone who has been diagnosed with Covid-19.

Quarantine Protocol Change: Last Thursday, the Waukesha County Health Department and the County Executive's office released **revised guidelines for quarantine of close contacts in a school setting**. This guidance allows close contacts the option of not completing quarantine assuming the school environment maintains layered mitigation measures including the requirement for universal masking. Vaccinations: On May 2nd we hosted an onsite vaccine clinic that included students 16 and older. The **second dose clinic** will be held from 2:00 - 5:00 p.m. *note this is a time change) in the PHS Auxiliary Gym on **May 23rd**. **Emergency authorization for children 12 and older** was approved just this week. We will be **expanding access to the May 23rd clinic for first doses for students 12 and older as a service to our families**. The second dose for those receiving their first dose on May 23rd will be **June 13th**. A registration link will be shared once we get closer to the 23rd. Please note that vaccination for COVID-19 is not required and parents should consult your family physician if you have questions or concerns.

The clinic will administer the Pfizer vaccine, which is the only C19 vaccine approved for 16 and 17 year old individuals at this time. Students who are fully vaccinated are not required to quarantine or get tested if exposed to individuals positive for COVID-19. Fully vaccinated individuals who become symptomatic for COVID-19 should get tested before returning to school. Currently there are studies underway for children 6 months to 11-years of age as well but vaccination for those age groups may not be available



until 2022.

If your student has been vaccinated, and you would like to update their records at school you can email that information to PSD-health@pewaukeeschools.org and our nursing staff will update the information.

Masking Requirement: Pewaukee School District continues to maintain and enforce a **requirement for wearing face coverings in our schools** for students, staff, and visitors. The CDC, DHS, Waukesha County Health, American Academy of Pediatrics and Children’s Hospital continue to stress universal masking as an essential virus mitigation strategy. The use of masking is also a necessary element for our adoption of the new quarantine guidelines from Waukesha County Health.

Support Resources: These atypical times have been shown to contribute to increases in mental health issues for students and adults as routines are disrupted and this can lead to feelings of isolation and helplessness. Data Table Terms

Active Cases: This term refers to individuals with a confirmed COVID-19 diagnosis who are not considered recovered. This would apply to any individual who has not completed the required 10-day isolation period which must also include 24-hours symptom free.

Probable COVID-19: This term refers to individuals who are symptomatic and have a known exposure to someone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19. Probable COVID-19 cases are included in the active cases data in the table below.

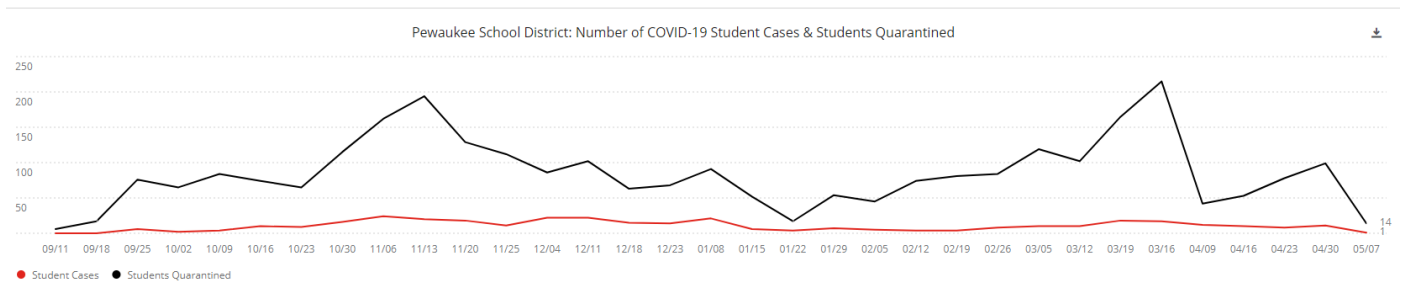
Quarantine: This term refers to individuals who are placed in quarantine due to a known exposure to an individual confirmed to have COVID-19 or due to the presentation of symptoms consistent with the virus.
